MBA Bachelor's Plus Master's Program

Highlights of the BPM Program

- An approximate discount of 36% off the current 2023-2024 per credit hour rate
 - Regular MBA rate: \$1,145
 BPM Rate: \$730
- Extends for up to four (4) consecutive terms immidately following graduation
 - This program takes a minimum of four terms to complete
 - With prior MBA approval, students have the ability to take their first semester off for an internship

The BPM Program does not apply to online graduate programs

Step 1: Apply for the BPM Discount

Submit your BPM application: <u>https://go.udayton.edu/mba-bpm</u>. Your BPM application should be submitted at the beginning of your senior year but no later than your last undergraduate semester. A GPA of 3.0 or better is required.

BPM acceptance does not automatically mean acceptance into the MBA program.

Step 2: Apply to the MBA Program

Submit your MBA program application: <u>https://dayton.force.com/graduate/</u>. *You must be admitted to the MBA program prior to graduating with your UD undergraduate degree in order to take advantage of the BPM discount.*

In addition to submitting your MBA program application, you must also submit the following:

- All transcripts from other schools (do not need to submit UD transcripts)
- Current resume
- Essay answering the prompts listed on the MBA website: <u>https://udayton.edu/business/graduate-academics/master of business administration/admission requirements.php</u>
- GMAT or GRE official scores may be requested after review of your application

Additional Information

- In order to stay in good academic standing and to graduate with an MBA, students must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA
- You may be eligible to double-count up to six credit hours towards both your undergraduate and graduate degrees. Permission must be obtained from the MBA program prior to taking any double-counted course.
- Non-business undergraduate students may also qualify for the BPM
