LOCATION(S) AND EMPLOYER ADVICE

Fill your schedule. Just because you haven't heard of a district doesn't mean that it wouldn't be the perfect opportunity. At least use the screening interviews for practice.

I liked that a few people wore a bright color. While they were still dressed professionally, something bright made those candidates stand out and be remembered against the sea of black/navy/gray and white.

Know the school system you are interviewing with. Instead of saying, I like the district's website, talk about details of district that interests you.

The only feedback is to focus your search on a broader area. Most of the candidates I spoke with only wanted specific districts or schools which will limit their options.

Be able to talk more about data, formative instructional practices, and mastering learning.

Be yourselves! If you did well in your classes, you have the theory and are ready for "the real world"... take the next step now and do so with confidence. (But be true to yourself in the process... don't hide who you are and expect to be happy in a job if you were being fake in the interview!)

Make sure they indicate all the licenses they will hold on their resume and on their name tag. As I talked with many of them I learned that they would hold even more licenses than what were listed.

Be sure to have your passion on display when interviewing. Partially through your physical presentation and partly through your depth of knowledge mixed with your personal feelings.
