Advice, comments, or suggestions to pass along to students/alumni:

With accounting internships, if interested in Public Accounting, be willing to do a winter internship, rather than a summer. They will get better experience, make more money and better position themselves for a full-time position after graduation. Be more flexible in location for your first job.

Overall they did very well.

My only suggestion would be to encourage them to do more interviews or practice interviews. It is usually obvious when we are their first interview ever. For our positions, the Flyer Enterprises can supplement quite well any lack of work experience.

As always, make sure they are well-versed in the companies (and the corresponding industries) they are interviewing with...what they do, who their customers are, where do they operate, etc.

1. Bring lots of questions to the Information Session - they were a bit quiet. 2. Any notes/binders/questions the students bring to the interview should look organized and formal. Saw a very broad range - scraps of paper with notes, 4+ colors of highlighted notes, some nice/neat typed thoughts.


