Directions

Getting To UD From I-75 Or I-70

1. From I-75, southbound (from Toledo)

a. Exit I-75 at #51 Edwin C. Moses Boulevard. Turn left and follow Edwin C. Moses Boulevard east to Stewart Street. Turn right and continue on Stewart Street to the University of Dayton.

2. From I-75, northbound (from Cincinnati)

a. Exit I-75 at #51 Edwin C. Moses Boulevard. Turn right and follow Edwin C. Moses Boulevard east to Stewart Street. Turn right and continue on Stewart Street to the University of Dayton.

3. From I-70, westbound (from Columbus)

a. Exit I-70 at I-675. Proceed southbound to state route 35. Take state route 35 west (toward Dayton) to I-75. Take I-75 south one exit to #51 Edwin C. Moses Boulevard. Turn left and follow Edwin C. Moses Boulevard east to Stewart Street. Turn right and continue on Stewart Street to the University of Dayton.

4. From I-70, eastbound (from Indianapolis)

a. Exit I-70 at I-75 south. Proceed southbound through Dayton and exit at #51 Edwin C. Moses Boulevard. Turn left and follow Edwin C. Moses Boulevard east to Stewart Street. Turn right and continue on Stewart Street to the University of Dayton.

Directions To...

1. Banks & ATMs

- a. Closest branches of banks:
 - i. PNC Bank 2720 Far Hills Ave, Oakwood. Take Brown Street south towards SR 48. Bear left onto SR 48/Far Hills. PNC bank will be on left after 1.4 miles.
 - ii. Chase 2800 Far Hills Ave, Oakwood. Take Brown Street south towards SR 48. Bear left onto SR 48/Far Hills. Chase bank will be on left after 1.7 miles.
- b. Campus ATM locations
 - i. Kennedy Union: Fifth Third, DayAir Credit Union, Key Bank
 - ii. Around Campus (All DayAir CU): V. W. Kettering Residence Hall, Marycrest, Campus South, Marianist Hall, RecPlex, and Fitz Hall.
 - iii. Around Campus: Kennedy Union, RecPlex and UD Arena

2. Grocery & Pharmacy

- a. Kroger: 1555 Wayne Ave. (Grocery store)
 - i. Take Brown St. north to Wyoming St. Turn right onto Wyoming. Turn right onto Wayne and Kroger is on the right.
- b. Walgreens: 1542 Wayne Ave. (Pharmacy)
 - i. Across from Kroger (see directions above)

- c. Meijer: 4075 Wilmington Pike (Super store including groceries and pharmacy)
 - Take Irving Ave. east to Wilmington. Turn right onto Wilmington. Stay on Wilmington for about three miles until you reach Stroop. After you cross Stroop Rd., the store is on your right
- d. Wal-Mart: 1701 W. Dorothy Lane (Super store including groceries and pharmacy)
 - i. Take Brown St. south onto Oakwood Ave. Turn right on E Schantz Ave. Turn left on S. Dixie Dr. and travel approximately 1 mile. Wal-Mart is on the right.

3. Malls

- a. The Greene (outdoor mall)
 - Located at Stroop and Indian Ripple in Kettering. Take SR 35 East to I-675 South. Take exit 10 for Indian Ripple Rd. Turn right at the end of ramp, and mall is immediately to your left.
- b. Dayton Mall
 - Located on SR 725 in Miami Township. Take I-75 South to exit 44 (Centerville/Miamisburg exit). Turn left at end of ramp and mall is approximately ½ mile on the right.
- c. Fairfield Commons Mall
 - Located on N. Fairfield Road at I-675. Take Route SR 35 East to I-675 North. Take the 2nd exit (North Fairfield Road). Turn right and the mall is approximately ¼ mile on the right.

Getting Around Without A Car

1. Shuttle Service (Saturdays)

https://www.udayton.edu/finadmin/divisions/fss/auxiliary/shuttle.php

a. Parking services offers a free shuttle to students on Saturdays from 11:15 a.m.to 4:00 p.m. Signs have been posted to identify each stop on campus. The shuttle will circle campus using a clockwise loop around campus with scheduled stops at Lot-A, rear of Marycrest, rear of Virginia W. Kettering, SW corner of Stuart Hall, Marianist/Founders Hall, Campus South and the McGinnis Center. From the McGinnis Center the bus will proceed to Governor's Place and Walmart on Dorothy Lane and S. Dixie. The bus will depart from Walmart on the hour and the last bus from Walmart will leave at 4:00 p.m.

Transportation to these areas will accommodate first year resident students who are not permitted to bring vehicles to campus as well as provide convenient transportation for upper-class students. Parking Services has contracted with Buckeye Charters to provide the service and is hopeful that the shuttle will provide students with effective alternative transportation.
