# **Special Interest House Timeline**

### 2022-2023

Groups are required to complete the 2022-2023 housing application and submit answers to the <u>SIH Application 21-22</u> application questions in order to be considered for a special interest house.

December 10, 2021	Last day to earn PATH credit
January 14, 2022	Groups interested in becoming a Legacy House, please review the <u>Application for Legacy House</u> information and submit a proposal to <u>housing@udayton.edu</u> .
January 17, 2022	Special Interest Housing Application Opens  - Special Interest Housing application opens on myHousing Portal:  myhousing.udayton.edu/starrezportalx  - Legacy House Advisers will have an access code for group leader to use to complete the Special Interest House application  - General Special Interest Housing groups will complete the application. If the group is approved, the group will be assigned to a property based on their PATH credit.
January 28, 2022	All applications must be completed and submitted online by 4:30 pm.
February 24, 2022	Groups will be informed of their Special Interest Housing assignment.
March 1, 2022	Groups must accept or decline their housing assignment.

February 28, 2022	General Housing Application opens

### Between Now and January 17, 2022

Groups need to collect the following information in preparation for submitting their online application for a special interest house:

- Determine a group leader for the house. This person, and only this person, will submit all application information on behalf of the group applying for a house.
- Collect the names of all group members.
  - NOTE: If you know that one group member is planning on studying abroad or co-oping out of town for one of the semesters, please prepare your plans for filling the vacancy.
- Collect the name, phone, and email for the group's House Adviser.
- Prepare answers to the <u>application questions</u>.

### Between January 17 and 28, 2022

## The **GROUP LEADER** will:

- Legacy Houses: Communicate with the House Adviser and gain the access code for the Special Interest House application
- All Groups:
  - Go to <u>myhousing.udayton.edu/starrezportalx</u> to complete an individual housing contract/application\*.
  - Create a roommate group, the group's name and a password.
    - Your group name should reflect your group name, year, and group leader name.

- Examples: Beta Theta Pi 2023 Christina Smith, Faith Vocation & Leadership 2023 Christina Smith, Outdoor Adventure Club 2023 Chrisitna Smith
- Email all roommate group members the name of the roommate group and password so that they can add their name to the roommate group that was created by the group leader.
- Cut and paste application answers into the appropriate text boxes in the housing portal.

### Each **GROUP MEMBER** will:

- Go to myhousing.udayton.edu/starrezportalx to complete their individual housing contract/application\*.
- Join the roommate group created by the group leader.
  - NOTE: Only the group leader will cut and paste the answers to the application questions and attach any documents.

\*The individual housing contract/application outlines the terms that a student must abide by in order to live in University housing. Each roommate will need to complete the housing contract in order to participate in the Special Interest Housing process.
