The Student Success Network (SSN) is a tool you can access through Porches that alerts students of problems that may become barriers to success in your class.

- · Poor scores
- Attendance issues
- Report non-attending students
- · Missed assignments
- · More!

With a couple of mouse clicks, you can notify students about problems and point them to available resources. It helps students to help themselves and informs them about where they stand in class before they come to your office. SSN helps make sure students have every chance to succeed in your class.
